



Malmstrom Spouses' Club 2026-2027 Scholarship Application

Welcome to the 2026-2027 Scholarship Program of the Malmstrom Spouses' Club (MSC). The MSC awards scholarships to outstanding dependents of the Malmstrom Air Force Base, to include tenant units and the Montana Air National Guard Station located in Great Falls, MT. The number and amount, as well as the total number of scholarships offered, are based on funds raised through the MSC's various fundraising efforts throughout the year.

All applications must be dropped off at the Malmstrom Thrift Store (107 77th Street North) during their business hours by **31 March** or mailed to: MSC- Scholarship Chair, PO BOX 7346, Great Falls, MT 59406 postmarked by **23 March**.

General Information / Criteria

1. The MSC offers merit-based scholarships to eligible dependents pursuing higher education or certifications.
2. An independent selection committee will evaluate all applications on a non-discriminatory basis.
3. All decisions made by the committee will be final. Any unwillingness on the part of the applicant or applicant's representative to abide by the scholarship committee's decision will result in rejection of the application.
4. Applicants will be notified by email of the results no later than 20 April.
5. Recipients will have until 27 April to accept or decline their offer.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must fit within one of the following categories:
 - a. Be a candidate for graduation from high school or certified home school program for the current school year and plan to attend an accredited college, university, technical school, or licensure/certification program during the 2026-2027 academic school year. OR
 - b. Must be currently enrolled in an accredited college, university, technical school, or licensure/certification program and will be continuing their studies during the 2026-2027 academic school year.
2. The applicant must be a legal military dependent, spouse or child, of either an Active-Duty Member, Active Guard or Reserve Member, Retired Member, or Deceased Active or Retired Members of the US military.
3. The military sponsor of the applicant must be physically stationed at or assigned to either the 341st MW Malmstrom Air Force Base, to include tenant units at MAFB or the 120th AW Montana Air National Guard at the time of application.

Limitations

1. Scholarship funds are to be used during the 2026-2027 academic year.
2. All funds received shall be applied to tuition and/or associated university fees/costs administered by an accredited college or university. These costs may include books, fees, room or board, but may not be used to cover fees from previous academic years, penalty fees or disenrollment fees.
3. Active Duty and Retired Service Members are not eligible to apply.
4. Applications and all required documents are subject to verification. Essays must be the original work of the applicant. Please note that any essay found to have been generated by AI tools (including ChatGPT) will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.
5. Applicants will be ineligible for this scholarship if they have been awarded a full scholarship, appointed to any military service academy, or received a full ROTC scholarship.
6. The Scholarship Chair will make **ONE** attempt to reach a winner by telephone if they have not responded to their notification email. If the Scholarship Chair does not hear back from the winner by 30 April, they forfeit their award with no exceptions.
7. Payment of the scholarship money will be made directly to the selected school upon formal acknowledgement of enrollment and verification of full-time student status. Recipients are required to provide college/university contact/financial aid information no later than 15 May. Checks will NOT be mailed until this information is received. CERTIFICATION LETTER

I certify that the information in the application is accurate to the best of my knowledge, and my essay is entirely my own effort. I further certify that I am a Malmstrom military dependent in possession of a valid military ID in my name and I meet all other MSC Scholarship Award eligibility requirements as stated in this application. Should I accept an MSC Scholarship Award, I acknowledge that the following restrictions apply:

1. Scholarship funds are to be used within the 2026-2027 academic year for an accredited technical certification, associate, bachelor, master, specialist or doctoral program. Funds shall be applied to tuition and/or associated university costs administered by an accredited college or university. These costs may include books, fees, room or board but may not be used for past or current penalties or disenrollment fees. The funds cannot be used for summer terms.
2. I will have until 27 April to email the scholarship chairperson of my acceptance of the award. In failing to do so, I will forfeit the award.
3. I will submit via email the name and address of the bursar's office of the school I will attend for the 2026-2027 academic year with verification of enrollment to the scholarship chairperson by 15 May.
4. After receiving the notice of acceptance of the award letter and the requested documents, the scholarship check, along with a cover letter with the terms of the scholarship, will be mailed directly to the college or university.
5. If I accept another full scholarship from any other source, I will notify the MSC scholarship committee immediately.
6. Funds that are unclaimed or designated for future use, as of October 1, 2026 will revert to the MSC Scholarship & Charity Fund.
7. I agree to the use of my name and picture concerning this award in local publications (area newspapers), and their websites, as well as MSC & Malmstrom Air Force Base publications & websites.
8. I understand that the MSC Scholarship Committee reserves the right to correspond with the selected school financial aid officer concerning the appropriate use of this award. Should questions or concerns arise, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withdraw unused funds until my standing is clarified to their satisfaction.
9. I understand that submission of an application in no way guarantees that a scholarship will be awarded. I understand that my application will not be considered if it is incomplete or submitted after the 31 March deadline.

2. My spouse works as a civilian on Malmstrom, Can I apply?

3. My spouse/parent served in the USAF for 7 years and got out. Can I apply?

No, Your spouse is a proud USAF veteran, but you are no longer considered a dependent.

4. In a prior year, I won a scholarship from another spouse club (ex. At a previous base) can I apply?

Yes.

5. In a prior year, I won a scholarship from MSC, can I apply?

Yes.

6. Can the check be made out to any other person/agency/landlord?

No, the check will only be written to the university or institution. We can notate to the bursar's office that the funding is specifically to be used for room and board to avoid competing with the GI bill.

7. Will you let me know when you have received my completed application?

Yes, you will receive an email when the Scholarship chair has received a completed application from you, to include receiving the reference letter.

8. We are a dual active-duty family. Can my spouse apply?

No, only non-military spouses may apply.

9. What is the timeline?

March 23: Mailed applications must be postmarked by this day

March 31: In person applications must be dropped off at Thrift Store

April 20: Scholarship Recipients will be notified via email

April 27: Scholarship Recipients must formally accept the scholarship
